

#### **FORESTRY**



The areas under management and leasing are 17.522 ha, (7 448 ha; 10 115 ha)

- of which 16.653 hectares are forest land.
- 28% of the total area is subject to nature conservation restrictions
- and with overlaps 59% of the area is NATURA 2000 area.



#### **FORESTRY**

- In addition to the protection purpose, our forestry performs significant public welfare and park forest tasks.
- In terms of topographic conditions, the forest areas managed by the Tanulmányi Erdőgazdaság Zrt. are well representative of our domestic conditions.



#### WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

TAEG Tanulmányi Erdőgazdaság Zrt manages two hunting areas on a total of 19.200 ha.

The hunting area, which includes:

- the Sopron mountains, provides 5.230 ha
- and the area in the Iván and Röjtökmuzsaj areas provides **13,970 ha.**



#### WOOD PROCESSING

- The Forestry was founded in 1951 as a practical base for forestry higher education.
- The expansion of the higher education institution with the faculty of wood industry naturally meant that it was also available to the university in this new field of education.
- The wood processing of forestry has undergone significant changes in recent decades.
- In 2000, the plant expanded with another activity, as the production of light-structured large-panel prefabricated houses with the LIGNOVA brand began.



#### LIGNOVA HOUSES



The Lignova Prefabricated Houses are made in the Wood Processing Plant operating as an independent unit of TAEG Zrt which has an annual turnover of billions every year.

- The company has decades of experience in house manufacturing and has been offering wood-based large panel technology products as one of the largest prefabricated house manufacturers in the country since 2000.

## Practical Education and Research

About one million guests visit it every year.

Sopron is a city of lookouts. The best known and most visited of the ten lookouts is the Károly-Lookout and its surroundings, which has become a symbol of the city.



#### **ACCOMODATIONS**

The TAEG Zrt. operates 4 hounting lodges.

In 2021 the company renewd an old forest house in the Hidegvíz-völgy (Coldwater valley), dedicated to the famous forestry professor Gyula Roth.

The latest accomodation, the Muck Turist House will be opend for 40 person during 2023 April, with an amazing surrounding, close to the visitor center and wildlife park.
